Summary: An ordinance changing business license fees.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 29.115  
OF CHAPTER 29 OF THE LOVELOCK CITY CODE  
BY INCREASING THE BUSINESS LICENSE FEES  
IN THE CITY OF LOVELOCK AND OTHER  
MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVELOCK DOES ORDAIN:

I

Section 29.115 of Chapter 29 shall read as follows:

29.115 License Fees. 1. Every person who engages in or pursues and business, occupation, trade, profession or calling mentioned in this subsection shall first apply for, pay for and obtain a license so to do in the manner provided by the Lovelock Municipal Cod, and shall make semiannual payments, payable in advance, for such license on January 1, and July 1, as follows.

2. For any other businesses, occupation, trade, profession or calling not specified in subsection 1 or anywhere in this chapter the semiannual license fee is \$34.00. the city council retains the right to impose reasonable requirements or conditions on businesses in order to protect the public, such as requiring bonds, proper housing for business, licenses or proof of special training for certain professions.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, the license fee may be paid annually in advance
